Friends, you will appreciate that trying to hold all possible combinations of communion administration across the team is proving a challenge and we appreciate your patience.

Please see below the current guidance:

# Sundays at Holy Trinity (10.45am) and St John's (10.30am), Knaresborough

☐ Those who wish to receive communion and partake of the common cup, put their hands up in plenty of time to receive the wafer (the chalice will follow).

☐ Those who wish intinction keep their hands crossed in front of them until the priest arrives directly in front of them allowing the priest to know to intinct.

☐ Those who are gluten-free receive intinction from the priest using the separate chalice on the altar.

☐ Those who wish only a blessing come to the altar with their hands by their sides and their heads down

# Sundays at St Mary's, Goldsborough (9am)

□ Due to St Mary's having only one administrant on a Sunday (and the above pattern for the Knaresborough churches not workable in the smaller church), we will revert to intinction by the priest for everybody.


